Catalyzing Climate Partnerships

As part of the ambitious 70% CO2 emissions reduction target by 2030 set by the Danish Government, BCG supported Dansk Industri in defining clear-cut climate action plans

The climate partnerships led to development of CO2 decarbonization models, initiatives and recommendations, while unlocking exciting insights:

Bringing sustainable solutions to life



WHAT

The Index Project is a nonprofit organization focusing on enabling the creation of sustainable solutions to global challenges. As part of this, they host a biennial award show with the largest design prize given by any organization worldwide.

Throughout the year, BCG supported The Index Project on two fronts:

- Offering our services to the start-up award winners
- Designing and conducting a strategy workshop with the Board of Directors

IMPACT

BCG supported 4 start-ups (2 in the US, 1 in Finland and 1 in Spain) in shaping their future trajectory. As an example, BCG's efforts included creating a view on the environmental impact along the fashion value chain and supporting with preparation of material for investor discussions.

The strategy workshop with the board has resulted in fundamental changes for The Index Project on why and how the organization operate including the pursuit of new revenue streams •



Fighting Child Cancer

BCG helped Børnecancerfonden strengthen their funding strategy, thus helping them on their commercialization journey. This was done in two tracks:

Theoretical: BCG defined a funding strategy with identified focus segments among three key donor groups (Foundations, Corporate, and Private) and recommended a channel approach for each segment

Practical: BCG helped them launch concrete initiatives, to help their funding both short- and long-term such as partnering with a digital marketing agency



The findings supported Børnecancerfonden in better prioritizing their resources and **establishing strategic priorities** for 2020 as well as the coming years

In the more near term, BCG's work helped Børnecancerfonden ensure **strong** result for 2020 in terms of donations despite the negative impact of Covid-19

Combating Antibiotic Resistance

THE CHALLENGE

Every year antibiotic-resistant infections kill at least 700,000 people globally. An immense health crisis, that could rise to 10 million by 2050

Given the nature of resistance, we will always need new antibiotics. There are too few antibiotics in development_to meet current and anticipated needs

Healthcare systems do not recognize the value of new antibiotics, therefore investments have declined, and biotech companies have gone bankrupt



IMPACT

BCG supported more than 20 of the world's biggest pharmaceutical companies in launching a \$1 billion fund - the AMR Action Fund - to tackle antibiotic resistance

The Fund aims to invest into the development of novel antibiotics and work with governments on reforms to ensure there is a sustainable innovation ecosystem for new antibiotics

Proving SMILfonden's Important Impact



WHAT

SMILfonden is a non-profit organization, supporting children with severe and chronic diseases and their families

Throughout the year, BCG supported SMILfonden in quantifying their impact and their value proposition to their target group i.e., families with serious or chronical ill kids

BCG conducted analyses based on a survey to healthcare professionals and the families engaged in SMILfonden's activities to understand and quantify the value proposition

IMPACT

The findings from the survey were incorporated into SMILfonden's fundraising- and communications material

The analysis showed that SMILfonden has a significant positive impact on the families' wellbeing

Moreover, SMILfonden eases the work performed by the healthcare professionals



Bringing Industry Leaders to Grow Gender Diversity



WHAT

BCG and UN Women Nordic Office bring together 19 Danish leaders in the Gender Diversity Roundtable (GDR), an initiative to share experiences and best practices on how to advance gender diversity in Denmark

It is a **beacon for gender diversity in Denmark** and provides perspectives to influence policymakers to create the optimal environment for gender diversity in Denmark

IMPACT

Since GDR establishment in 2017, members have made **significant strides in bettering diversity** in their respective organizations and companies

We have made ~30 press releases and media segments along multiple research reports on diversity in Denmark ensure continuous relevance and focus

This year, we also **published a report** on why companies and organizations need to **consider bias and ethics in Al**
